

Discipline Guidelines for Students

1. General Conduct

- Maintain professionalism and ethical behavior in the classroom, labs, and clinical settings.
- Respect faculty, staff, patients, and fellow students.
- Follow all rules and regulations of the institution.
- Any form of misconduct, including harassment or bullying, will not be tolerated.

2. Attendance & Punctuality

- Students must maintain a minimum of **75% attendance** in all classes and practical sessions.
- Arrive on time for lectures, labs, and clinical postings.
- Late arrivals may not be allowed to enter the class.
- Inform the concerned faculty in advance in case of unavoidable absence.

3. Dress Code

- Wear a **proper lab coat** and maintain a neat appearance.
- Follow institutional dress code guidelines, especially in clinical areas.
- Avoid wearing casual attire like jeans, T-shirts, or slippers in the lab or hospital.

4. Academic Integrity.

- Complete all assignments and practical work on time.
- Maintain proper records of lab work and follow research ethics.

5. Classroom & Lab Etiquette

- Keep mobile phones **on silent mode** or switched off during lectures and practical sessions.
- Handle lab equipment with care and follow safety protocols.
- Keep the lab, classroom, and hospital premises clean.

6. Clinical Postings & Patient Interaction

- Follow **all hospital rules and guidelines** during clinical training.
- Treat patients with **respect, empathy, and confidentiality**.
- Maintain professional behavior with doctors, technicians, and other hospital staff.
- **Unauthorized handling of medical equipment or patient data is strictly prohibited.**

7. Use of Technology & Social Media

- Do not record or share class/clinical sessions without prior permission.

By adhering to these guidelines, students will ensure a **productive, professional, and respectful** learning environment.


- Discipline committee of FAHS will take a round twice a week at least and if any students found in such in disciplinary activity cited above may lead strict action.
