

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University in collaboration with SGT Marketing Team organized a dental as well as medical camp (eye check-up) at Bhai Joga Singh Public School, Karol Bagh, New Delhi on 10/01/2024.

The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Professor and Head, of Public Health Dentistry).





The dental team was headed by Dr. Navodita Jamwal, Assistant Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry and 5 interns namely Trisha, Diksha, Simran, Manuj and Tanvi along with Mr. Darshan (Attendant). Dental screening of 155 children (Girls – 40; Boys – 115) from different classes of school took place.

All patients were given referral slips. The children got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral health.

Importance of maintaining good and hygienic oral health was verbally delivered to the children by faculty and the interns. An oral hygiene kit consisting of a toothpaste, tooth brush and mouthwash was distributed to the children.

With the involvement of every single member of the dental team and their enormous efforts, health education and health promotion were achieved at its best.

The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University conducted oral health screening program on 15th January 2024 (Monday) at Mata Daan Kaur Public School, Najafgarh, Delhi.

The activity was organized under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. and Head Department of Public Health Dentistry). The Dental team was headed by Dr. Charu Khurana (Associate Professor, Department of Public Health Dentistry) along with 2 postgraduates Dr. Mahima (Department Pedodontics) and Dr. Prashant (Department Orthodontics) along with 6 BDS Interns Chetan, Apurva, Tanishka, Kritika, Lischica, Divyanshi and 1 attendant Mr. Sunil. A total of 361 students from classes 3rd till 8th were examined which included 218 boys and 143 girls. Along with students, oral health examination was done for some of the Teachers and supporting staff in the school. To encourage the children to adopt healthy oral practices, an oral hygiene kit consisting of a toothpaste, tooth brush and awareness material was also distributed.





An oral health talk session was taken by Dr. Charu Khurana where she demonstrated the appropriate brushing technique and mentioned about the adverse oral habits, oral hygiene importance, ill effects of tobacco consumption. The purpose of the Oral Health drive was to create awareness among the students and make them understand the importance of oral health care. Students who required dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental hospital for further treatment.




This dental camp provided created awareness towards importance of good oral health among school children and motivated them to follow oral hygiene instructions in routine and lead a healthy life.

- 87. Objective of the Activity: To observe the World Cancer Day & create awareness among the people about cancer and common oral diseases and to Promote General Health & Dental Health.
- 88. Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s)explaining activities undertaken: The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, organized the Oral Health Screening and Treatment activity on





February 8, 2024 at Village Yakubpur, Jhajjar to observe World Cancer Day. It is an international awareness day led by the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC) celebrated on February 4 every year. As per the WHO Regional Director for Africa, between 2022 and 2024, the focus of World Cancer Day is to help "close the cancer gap." To commemorate World Cancer Day, a total of 50 patients, including 20 males and 30 females were examined and 22 patients were treated at the camp site in Mobile Dental Van. Patients who required complex dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental Hospital for further procedures. An oral health talk was prepared and presented by the interns, focusing on the causes of cancer and how to prevent it using charts and models. The general population gave positive feedback and appreciated the check-up and patient care provided by the dental team. The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University conducted an oral health screening program on 12th February 2024 (Monday) at Divine Dale International School, Pataudi.

The Dental team took initiative under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Head of Dept. & Associate Dean). The Dental team was headed by Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Senior Lecturer, Department of Public Health Dentistry) along with 1 postgraduate Dr. Shweta (Department of Pedodontics) 6 Interns Chetan, Apoorva, Mahima, Sweety, Kritika, Tanishka and 1 attendant Mr. Sunil. A total of 225 students from classes Pre-Nursery to XIIth were examined which included 136 boys and 89 girls. Along with students, oral health examination was done for some of the teachers and supporting staff members in the school.

An oral health talk session was delivered which included importance of brushing, procedure of mouthwash usage and oral hygiene instructions. Doubts regarding toothbrushing technique, oral hygiene products and questions raised by students during oral health talk session were also answered. Oral Health Education was imparted regarding the importance of adopting a healthy lifestyle through brushing techniques, models and charts.





The purpose of the Oral Health drive was to create awareness among the students and make them understand the importance of oral health care.

Students who required dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental hospital for further treatment.

111. Number & Description of Beneficiaries:

The Beneficiaries were students of Divine Dale International School from Classes LKG to XIIth. 225 students came forward for their Dental Check-up out of which 136 were boys and 89 were girls. Children were given demonstrations for brushing technique. Majority of the students had good oral hygiene however some children had Dental Caries, grossly decayed teeth and extrinsic stains.

112. Outcome of the Activity & its relevance to Health Sciences:

The activity was well appreciated by the School Authorities. Proper brushing technique was demonstrated to educate the children and their teachers regarding the importance of proper oral hygiene maintenance. Two hundred and twenty-five students were examined. Young Children were also shown educational videos to reinforce the oral health education imparted to them. The interns and postgraduates worked in tandem and learnt the nuances of working at an outreach setting in a





school setting while realizing the importance of good teamwork and soft skills related to patient management at an outreach setting.
