

- 3. <u>Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s)explaining activities</u> undertaken

Dental check-up camp was organized by the Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University on 2nd May, 2024 (Thursday) at Good Shepherd Pre School & Day Care, Gurgaon.

The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head). The dental team was headed by Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with postgraduate student Dr. Nidhi (Dept. of Pedodontics) and interns Sukanya, Mamta, Himanshi, Deeksha, Ekta, Rahul. Mr. Sunil (Attendant) accompanied the dental team. Oral health screenig of 187 students from classes Nursery to IInd was done. The children were between the age group of 3 to 7 years.

The primary goal of this session was to increase the access and utilization of dental care at grass root levels and also to create awareness among the community. Oral health talk was rendered focusing on the importance of maintenance of oral hygiene. Demonstration of toothbrushing technique was given with the help of dentoform model. To encourage the children to adopt healthy oral practices, an oral hygiene kit was distributed. Students who



required dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental hospital for further treatment.

The camp was organized to create awareness related to the issues of oral health and the importance of oral hygiene and concluded with a high hope that the team has moved a step forward in creating an orally healthier community.

## 4. Number & Description of Beneficiaries:

The Beneficiaries were students of Good Shepherd Pre-School from Classes Nursery to IInd as well as teaching and non-teaching staff members. 187 students came forward for their Dental Check-up. Children were given demonstrations for brushing technique. Majority of the students had good oral hygiene however some children had Dental Caries, grossly decayed teeth and extrinsic stains.

## 5. Outcome of the Activity & its relevance to Health Sciences:

The activity was well appreciated by the School Authorities. Proper brushing technique was demonstrated to educate the children and their teachers regarding the importance of proper oral hygiene maintenance. One hundred and eighty-seven students were examined. Young Children were also shown educational videos to reinforce the oral health education imparted to them. The interns worked in tandem and learnt the nuances of working at an outreach setting in a school setting while



realizing the importance of good teamwork and soft skills related to patient management at an outreach setting.



# 12. Objective of the Activity:

To create awareness among the children about common oral diseases and to Promote Oral Health.



The Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University in collaboration with SGT Marketing team organized a dental camp on 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2024 at *Good Shepherd Pre School*.

The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon ( Prof. and Head, Public Health Dentistry). The dental team was headed by Dr. Rangoli Srivastava (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with 2 postgraduates — Dr.Rahul(PG-PHD), , Dr. Prashant (PG-Ortho) along with 6 interns— Sukanya, Harshit, Vinay, Vidish, Khushi, Disha along with Mr. Sunil (Attendant) accompanied us. Dental checkup of 184 children were done.

Emphasis was done on motivating patients to maintain good oral hygiene. Toothpaste, toothbrushes, mouthwash were distributed among the patients on account of the same purpose. Positive feedback was obtained from participants. Cases requiring complex treatment were referred to SGT Dental College. All patients were given referral slips. The children got ample opportunities to interact with the dental surgeons to enquire and gain knowledge concerning oral diseases. Necessary oral hygiene instructions were given to required adults and children.

Importance of maintaining good and hygienic oral health was verbally delivered to the children and adults.

With the involvement of every single member of the dental team and their enormous efforts, motive of the dental camp was achieved to its maximum.

## 42. <u>Brief Write-up (300 -500 words) on the event(s)explaining activities</u> undertaken

Dental check-up camp was organized by the Department of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University on 2nd May, 2024 (Thursday) at BVM SCHOOL, GURUGRAM.

The dental team took initiative under guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Associate Dean and Prof. and Head). The dental team was headed by Dr. Surbhi Priyadarshi (Senior Lecturer, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry) along with postgraduate student Dr. Indrani (Dept. of Oral Medicine and Radiology) and interns Sukanya, Mamta, Himanshi, Deeksha, Harshit, Priyank. Mr. Sunil (Attendant) accompanied the dental team. Oral health screenig of 122 students from classes Pre-Nursery to Illrd was done. The children were between the age group of 3 to 10 years.

The primary goal of this session was to increase the access and utilization of dental care at grass root levels and also to create awareness among the community. Oral health talk was rendered focusing on the importance of maintenance of oral hygiene. Demonstration of toothbrushing technique was given with the help of dentoform model. To encourage the children to adopt healthy oral practices, an oral hygiene kit was distributed. Students who required dental treatment were referred to SGT Dental hospital for further treatment.



The camp was organized to create awareness related to the issues of oral health and the importance of oral hygiene and concluded with a high hope that the team has moved a step forward in creating an orally healthier community.

## 43. Number & Description of Beneficiaries:

The Beneficiaries were students of BVM School from Classes Pre-Nursery to Illrd as well as teaching and non-teaching staff members. 112 students came forward for their Dental Check-up. Children were given demonstrations for brushing technique. Majority of the students had good oral hygiene however some children had Dental Caries, grossly decayed teeth and extrinsic stains.

## 44. Outcome of the Activity & its relevance to Health Sciences:

The activity was well appreciated by the School Authorities. Proper brushing technique was demonstrated to educate the children and their teachers regarding the importance of proper oral hygiene maintenance. One hundred and twelve students were examined. Young Children were also shown educational videos to reinforce the oral health education imparted to them. The interns worked in tandem and learnt the nuances of working at an outreach setting in a school setting while realizing the importance of good teamwork and soft skills related to patient management at an outreach setting.







Eng. Pvt. Limited, Gurugram on 22nd May, 2024. The event aimed to raise awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use on oral health.

The camp included medical and dental team members, under the guidance of Dr. Shourya Tandon (Prof. & Head, Department of Public Health Dentistry). 

A health talk was delivered simultaneously on how to take care of the teeth, importance of brushing, proper brushing technique, balanced diet, handling dental emergencies. like toothbrush, toothpaste were distributed to the needy one's. Satisfactory feedback was obtained from the school official authorities. The patients were also given referral slips and were referred to SGT University for further needful treatment.
